Thanks to all who have submitted Estimates of Giving for 2026. We are working on our budget for 2026, and many programs of the church depend upon your Estimate of Giving. Thank you for your faithfulness!



The mission committee met with Mark Adams of Frontera de Cristo via Zoom at our November meeting. He told us about their current mission activities, primarily the Educational Enrichment Program of before & after school activities aimed at both better education and giving elementary students the idea of & belief in other life paths than poverty, drugs & trafficking. They have or are setting up 3-4 program centers near elementary schools in Agua Prieta, Mexico & hope to start another 1 on the U.S. side of the wall in Douglas, AZ. Douglas & Agua Prieta consider themselves to be sister cities, 1 community. They also started Café Justo 18 years ago, a coffee shop & community center in Agua Prieta, connected with the coffee-growing community in Chiapas on the border with Guatemala, helping to create a sustainable agricultural system where farmers can stay on their land & be able to support their families instead of migrating. They also have Migrant Resource Centers on both sides of the border, & a wonderful cooperative program with PCUSA's YAV (Young Adult Volunteers) program.

There are many more enterprises & faith based activities with videos on their website, https://fronteradecristo.org/our-mission/. We voted to send \$500 to their mission & to look into further supportive interactions. This is an amazing organization & we encourage to check out their website & videos.

Updates:

\$500 has been sent to support the antitrafficking group in the Philippines that Cathy Chang has been working with.

Billie Bauer took 31 stockings to I Support the 1% veterans outreach. Thank you for the congregation's generosity!

Our amount from the Peace & Global Witness donations came to \$126.25. that will go toward donations to The Well, Mustard Seed & Forgotten Youth Ministries, supplemented from SERRV account funds to send \$300 to each.

The collection of winter wear has started for 2026. Place any donations in the schoolhouse in the "Mission Corner."
