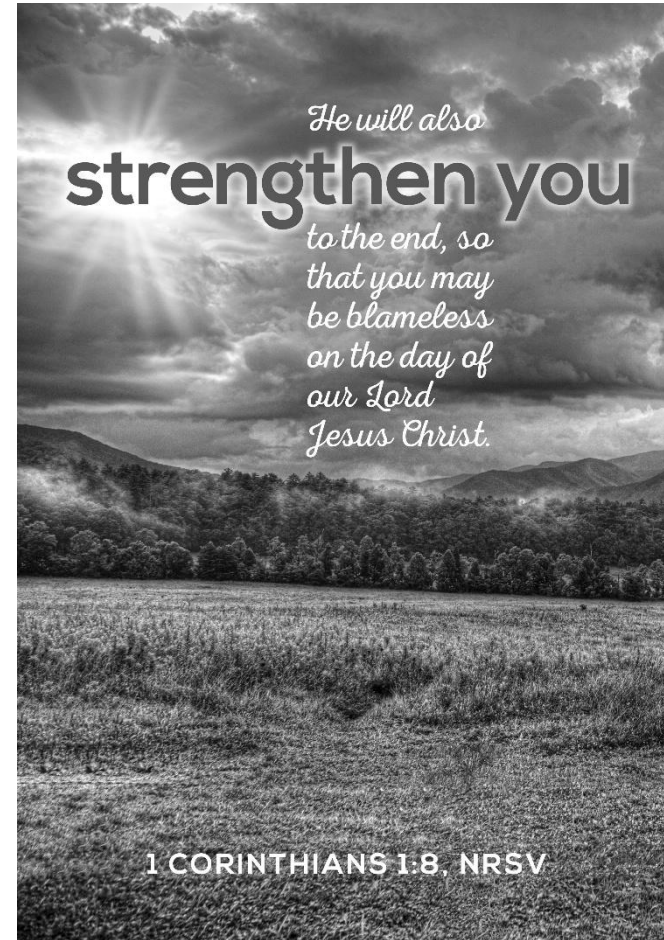

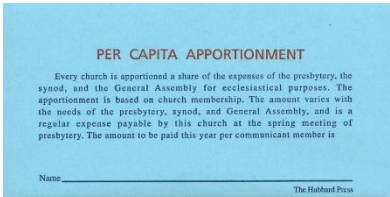
Session Training is Saturday, January 24 from 10:00 a.m. until Noon. All elders, newly elected or currently serving, are strongly encouraged to attend.

Per Capita:



The special envelope for January is the Per Capita envelope. Per Capita is part of being a Presbyterian and connecting to the Presbyterian Church as a whole; it is part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together. The total 2026 Per Capita for our church is \$7,840.00, which equates to **\$35.00 per member**

(not per household). This goes to General Assembly, Synod of the Covenant and the Presbytery. If each member pays their Per Capita amount above their regular giving then pressure on our budget is reduced. Please mark Per Capita on your check or envelope.

On the cart outside the office, you will find a form to fill out if you happen to notice a maintenance issue, either inside or outside the church building. Please fill out the form and leave it in the top bin. We ask that you DO NOT try to fix the issue yourself.
